

Contest Rules

Article 1 – ORGANIZER

This competition is organized without any purchase obligation by Brussels Airlines NV, with registered office at Jaargetijdenlaan 100-102, box 30, 1050 Brussels, with company number 400.853.488.

Brussels Airlines is hereinafter referred to as “the organizer” or “Brussels Airlines”. These rules describe how the competition operates and set out the conditions of participation.

Article 2 – PARTICIPATION

All natural persons residing in Belgium may participate in this competition, with the exception of employees of the organizer, directors of the organizer, and any other persons involved in the creation of this competition, as well as family members of the above-mentioned categories of natural persons.

The competition runs exclusively via www.catch-a-flight.be. Only persons aged 18 or older may participate. Multiple entries per email address are allowed, but participation is limited to one entry per flight.

Participation in this competition is completely free of charge.

Article 3 – COMPETITION MECHANISM

The competition runs from 19 January 2026 until 25 January 2026 at 23:59 CET. To participate validly, the participant must spot a Brussels Airlines flight via the following URL: www.catch-a-flight.be, answer a tie-break question, and complete their contact details via the form in the final step of the competition. To be eligible for the prize offered by Brussels Airlines, the participation form must be completed in full. Registrations and personal data must be received by the organizer no later than 25 January at the end of the day at 23:59 CET.

Any disputes regarding the time of submission are assessed based on the server time of the organizer. Incomplete forms are not eligible to win.

The organizer reserves the right to verify the accuracy of the information provided by participants, including age, identity, and place of residence. The organizer may exclude a participant at any time and definitively in the event of a breach of the participation conditions, provision of a false identity, or abuse, fraud, or bad-faith participation in the competition.

Participation is possible in English, French, and Dutch.

Participation in the competition is only possible via mobile devices. The user experience varies depending on the type of mobile device and the operating system used. The organizer accepts no responsibility for technical limitations, compatibility issues, or reduced functionality on certain mobile devices or operating systems.

Article 4 – WINNERS

The 50 winners are selected at the end of the competition.

The winners are the participants who correctly spot a Brussels Airlines flight and provide the answer closest to the correct answer to the tie-break question. In the event of a tie, the winner is selected by a lucky draw.

If multiple identical answers and identical registration times occur, the winners are determined by lot.

Article 5 – PRIZE

50 winners receive a Brussels Airlines voucher with a value of EUR 250. The winners receive an email with more information after the competition ends. The prize, either in full or in part, is not payable in cash and cannot be exchanged for another prize in kind.

Article 6 – RULES AND ACCEPTANCE

By ticking the checkbox on the form, the participant declares agreement with the conditions and privacy regulations of this competition.

Article 7 – INTERPRETATION AND CORRESPONDENCE

Any dispute relating to the interpretation of these competition rules, as well as any situation not provided for in the rules, is decided by an internal jury appointed by the organizer.

Except for the cases provided for in Article 4, the organizer does not respond to written, telephone, or oral questions regarding the interpretation or application of these rules, the course of the competition, or the list of participants or winners.

Article 8 – VERIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE

Winners and participants agree that the organizer has the right at any time to verify their identity or place of residence as provided. The provision of false, incomplete, or incorrect data regarding identity or address, whether email or postal address, leads automatically to disqualification of the participant concerned.

Article 9 – LIABILITY

The organizer reserves the right to postpone, modify, or cancel the competition due to force majeure or any other cause beyond the control of the organizer, including but not limited to technical incidents related to failures of the computer system used, fraudulent access to the computer system, defects, interruptions, or delays in telecommunications networks. The organizer also excludes any liability for issues related to electronic data transmission which prevent participants from taking part in the competition or from registering in a valid manner.

In addition, the organizer accepts no liability for any damage of any kind resulting from the awarding of the prizes. The organizer also excludes any liability for possible defects in the prizes.

Article 10 – PRIVACY AND DATA PROTECTION

The organizer acts in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation EU 2016/679 and its online Privacy Policy. Personal data collected from participants within the scope of the competition are processed by Brussels Airlines as data controller. By participating in the competition, the participant grants Brussels Airlines permission to use personal data for the purpose of managing the competition and identifying the winners. Participants have the right to access, correct, or request deletion of personal data from the database. Participants who request deletion of personal data during the course of the competition accept automatic termination of participation, since participation requires registration on the list of participants.

The personal data processed are:

- Full name
- Email address
- Location data

These data are deleted after full completion of the competition, once all winners have been informed. Brussels Airlines uses the data for no other purposes.

Personal data of participants are shared only with the partner established within the EU who works with Brussels Airlines to enable the technical operation of the competition.

Article 11 – VALIDITY

If any provision of these rules proves to be unlawful, invalid, or unenforceable for any reason, that provision is considered separable from the competition rules and does not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.

The separated provisions must be interpreted and or replaced by valid provisions with the same purpose and effect, or by equivalent provisions or provisions that approximate the original provision as closely as possible.

Article 12 – APPLICABLE LAW AND JURISDICTION

This competition is governed by Belgian law, regardless of regulations relating to conflicts of laws. The participant accepts that any legal action resulting from participation in the competition or relating to the competition rules falls under the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Brussels, Belgium, and accepts submission to the jurisdiction of these courts in the context of such action.
